

Clitheroe

The station forms part of Clitheroe Interchange with bus services radiating to most parts of the Ribble Valley. Links to the Forest of Bowland National Landscape and Pendleside make it possible to explore these beautiful areas. Eco Escapes provides car free itineraries to explore the area. 

Whalley

A town that boasts some very fine church buildings of which the best known is Whalley Abbey, a former Cistercian Abbey. Cistercian monks settled in Whalley in 1296 and started to build the Abbey Church in 1330. Whilst nearby stands the ancient church of St Mary's and All Saints, also 4th century. Equally impressive is Whalley Viaduct carrying the railway over the River Calder. It is 679 yards long, has 48 spans and was made from 7 million bricks.

Blackburn station has some fascinating artwork around the station created by local schools and groups. On platform 4 there is also the steel artwork depicting famous people connected with the town including Barbara Castle and Mahatma Ghandi. There is plenty to see in Blackburn. Take a look at the Cathedral which is opposite the station, the Market and events at King Georges Hall.

Explore Darwen and the surrounding area taking in the Spitfire Memorial, Sunnyhurst, Bold Venture Park and the Jubilee Tower with its great views across East Lancashire.

Bolton

There is plenty to see and do in Bolton. The Bolton Art Gallery, Library and Museum in Le Mans Crescent, near the Town Hall, is well worth a visit and for theatre goers there is the Octagon Theatre. Bolton market, in Ashburner Street, can trace its history back to 1251 in the reign of Henry III.
