West of Lancashire CRP Activity Plan Report 12th October, 2023





Key Updates:

The national ticket office closure proposals: Three ticket offices have been identified for closure namely Parbold, Preston and Wigan North Western with Wigan Wallgate remaining open. Ormskirk and Southport are unaffected by these proposals.. Impacts on equality, equity and disability were highlighted and have fed into consultation responses compiled by Community Rail Lancashire and Lancashire County Council. Encouragement was also given for Rail User Groups, Friends of Stations and District Councils to also reply to the Transport Focus consultation. It is understood that over 680,000 responses were made – clearly demonstrating the need for further thought about this issue. Concurrently there was also a petition which gained 100,000 signatures and resulted in a parliamentary debate.

I can forward the responses made by CRL to both the Northern and Avanti West Coast consultations.

ComREG (Northern Community Rail Executive Group): the last meeting took place on the 13th September 2023 at which regional updates were given. DDawn McGough, Community Rail Cumbria, compiles the report for the west area and thanks to Stephen for his input to this.


