It is a three-year pay deal (at 5%, 4.75% and 4.5%) with no strings.

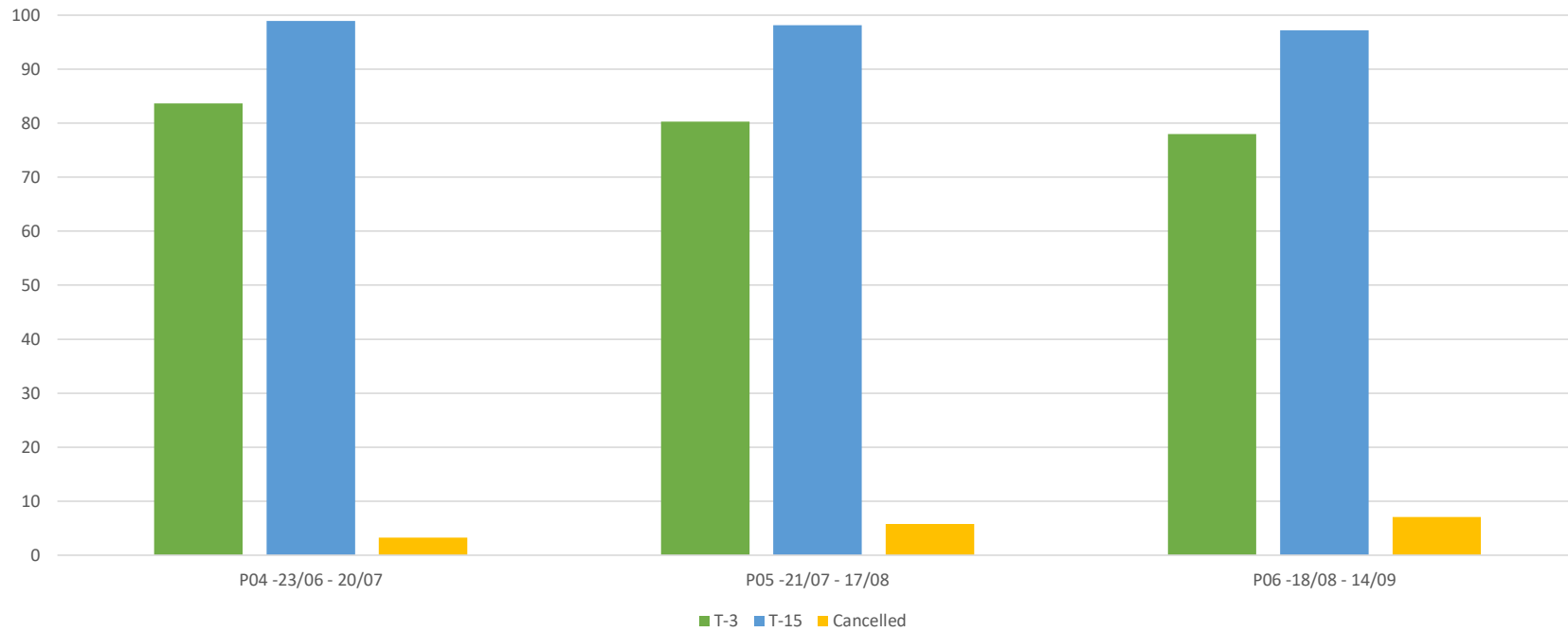
