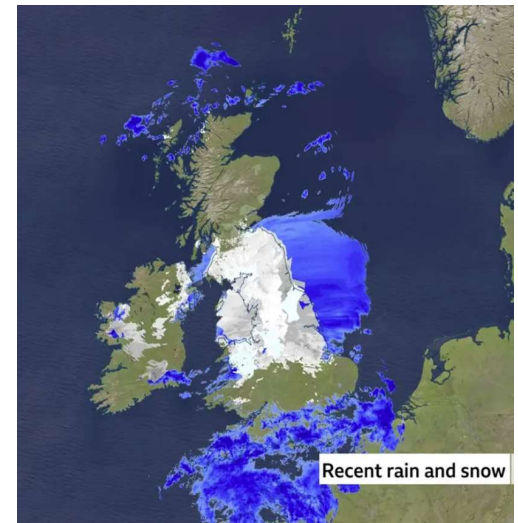

Class 769 Performance Improvement Programme/Infrastructure

- 2x additional 769s to join the fleet whilst 8x Northern units receive overhauls
- Powerpack and engine harness enhancements
- Improvements to doors
- Lostock Junction-Wigan North Western electrification energized from early January
- 769s to operate on electric power Bolton-Ince from May 2025
- Later trains to/from Southport reinstated from May 2025

Map showing Wigan to Bolton Electrification Scheme and extent of energisation

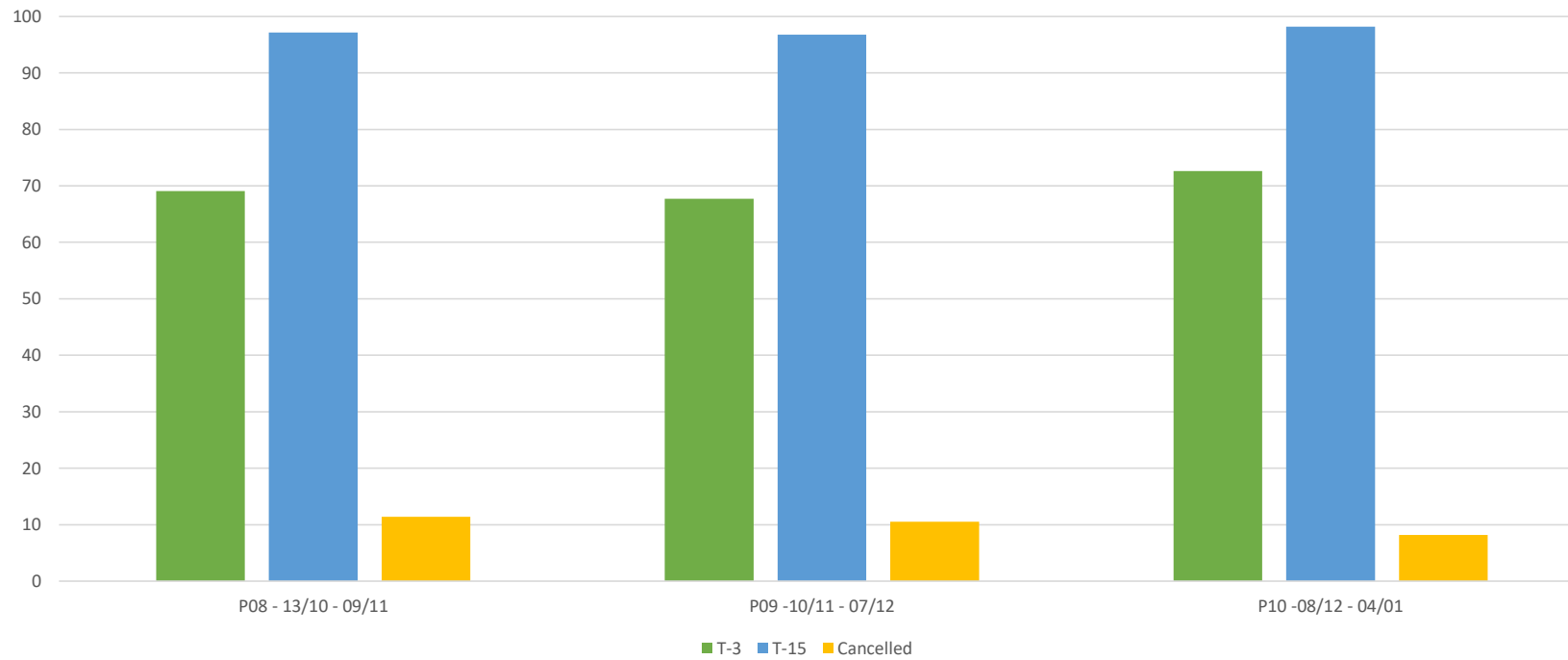

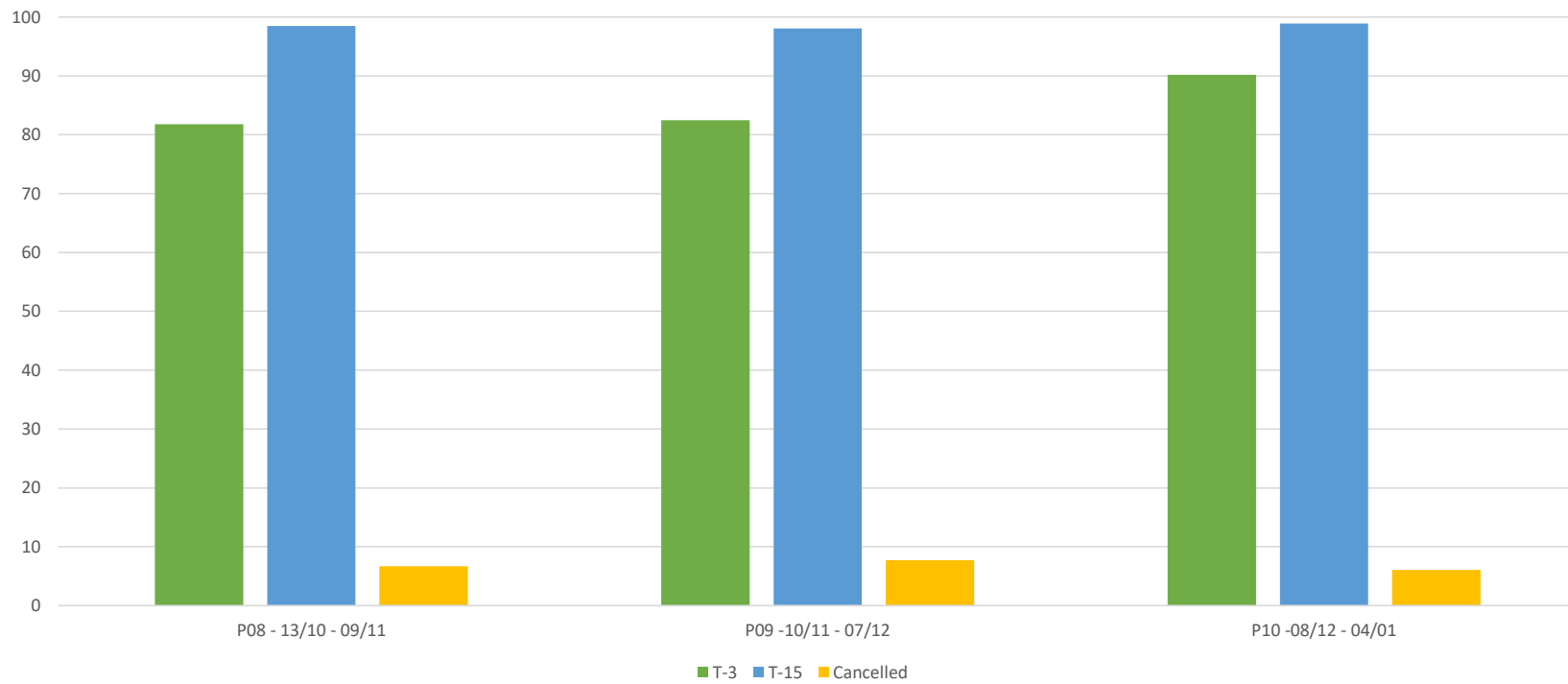

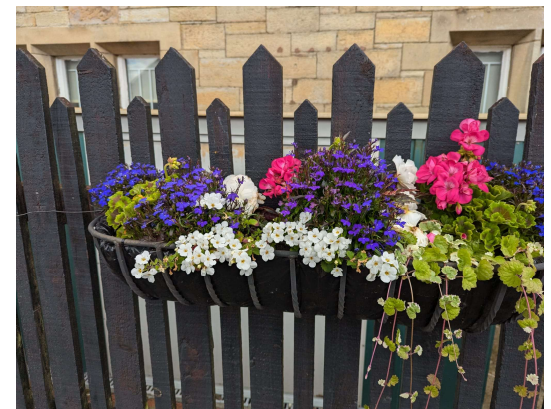
