Feel Good Field Trips project completed

The Feel Good Field Trip campaign funded by Avanti West Coast has been up and running since January 2023. The project has provided over 5200 school children aged between 4-18 with the chance to go on free, enriching and educational days out across the West Coast Mainline. The schools involved have higher than average pupil premium rates (24%).
