It leads 4 Lancashire Community Rail Partnerships (CRPs).

It delivers rail-based education across the north of England under the TrainEd brand.

The CRPs support a range of community-based activities and special projects. For example:

THE YORKSHIRE DALES EXPLORER: this Saturday leisure-based service links Greater Manchester and Lancashire with the world-famous Settle Carlisle line.

EXPLORE LANCASHIRE BY RAIL: this is an expanding series of short films showcasing great ways to explore locally by train. Take a look and then take the train!

GUIDED WALKS: in partnership with the Lancashire Rail Ramblers and the Friends of the Settle Carlisle Line a comprehensive range of guided walks is available to help you explore Lancashire and beyond with an experienced and knowledgeable guide.

SPECIAL PROJECTS: CRL, the CRPs and TrainEd work with many school and community groups to develop special, often station based, projects.

TRY THE TRAIN is for community, school and youth groups aged 14+ years, with an aim to enable people to travel by train with more confidence.

TrainEd

TrainEd is a rail-based education programme delivered by CRL's team of education specialists.

The TrainEd programme offers sessions on:

- **Railway confidence** – which may include journey planning; how to read a timetable; which ticket to buy and a guided rail journey.
- **Rail safety** – the dos and don'ts explained.
- **Careers** – finding out about the many different roles within the rail industry.
- **Sustainability** – how the railway is contributing to tackling climate change. Trips to Accrington Eco Station are recommended.

Programmes can be delivered in schools, at Accrington Eco Station, on trains or at community centres.

TrainEd also supports some special projects such as the Northern Education Network which includes quarterly live meetings at venues across the north of England. The network is also open to all CRPs, station adoption groups, education specialists and rail industry partners.
